

Call for Applications

ERASMUS+ Grant for Study Abroad at BTU Cottbus-Senftenberg

Duration:

3 months, during the winter term 2024/2025 (October - March)

What is funded?

ERASMUS+ awards a monthly grant of **850 EUR for a study abroad semester at BTU Cottbus-Senftenberg** (Germany). Furthermore, scholarship-holders will receive a one-time subsidy of **275 EUR** towards their travel expenses. The grant does not include health insurance and insurance for accident and personal liability.

Requirements for participation in the ERASMUS+ programme:

- Enrolment/Registration at Université de Carthage as regular degree seeking student (BA, MA, PhD)
- Completion of the first year of study at the home university (not applicable for Master's and PhD students)
- Good or very good academic standing
- Sufficient language skills for the study abroad (language of instruction at the partner university)

Application documents:

- Completed ERASMUS+ application form
- Transcript of Records (Certification of grades obtained at home university)
- Learning Agreement, signed by student and home university
- Evidence of student status at home university (confirmation of enrolment/registration)
- Evidence of language proficiency (**English or German language skills, minimum level B1**)
- Signed motivation letter with precise description of the academic/professional and personal reasons for the study abroad
- CV (e.g. Europass specimen form at: <http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>)
- *Optional*: Recommendation letter from a professor/teacher
- Copy of passport

Application and selection process

The Université de Carthage nominates the candidates for the ERASMUS+ grant and students will then have the opportunity to officially apply via an online portal (provided by BTU) to upload all required documents.

The selection committee of BTU, represented by professors and lecturers of the respective faculty decides on the awarding of the ERASMUS+ grant among the applications received. The most decisive criteria for the selection process are previous academic achievements, personal motivation, and language skills. If there are several candidates with a similar level of academic achievements, the decision will consider the socio-economic background and personal presentation of the candidates' professional and personal motivation for the study abroad.
